```

```
find . -exec sh -c "file '{} ' | grep -q 'pattern'" \; -print
```

Mit Mimetype

```
find . -type f -exec bash -c '  
  [[ "$( file -bi "$1" )" == */x-shellscript* ]]' bash {} \; -print

```
